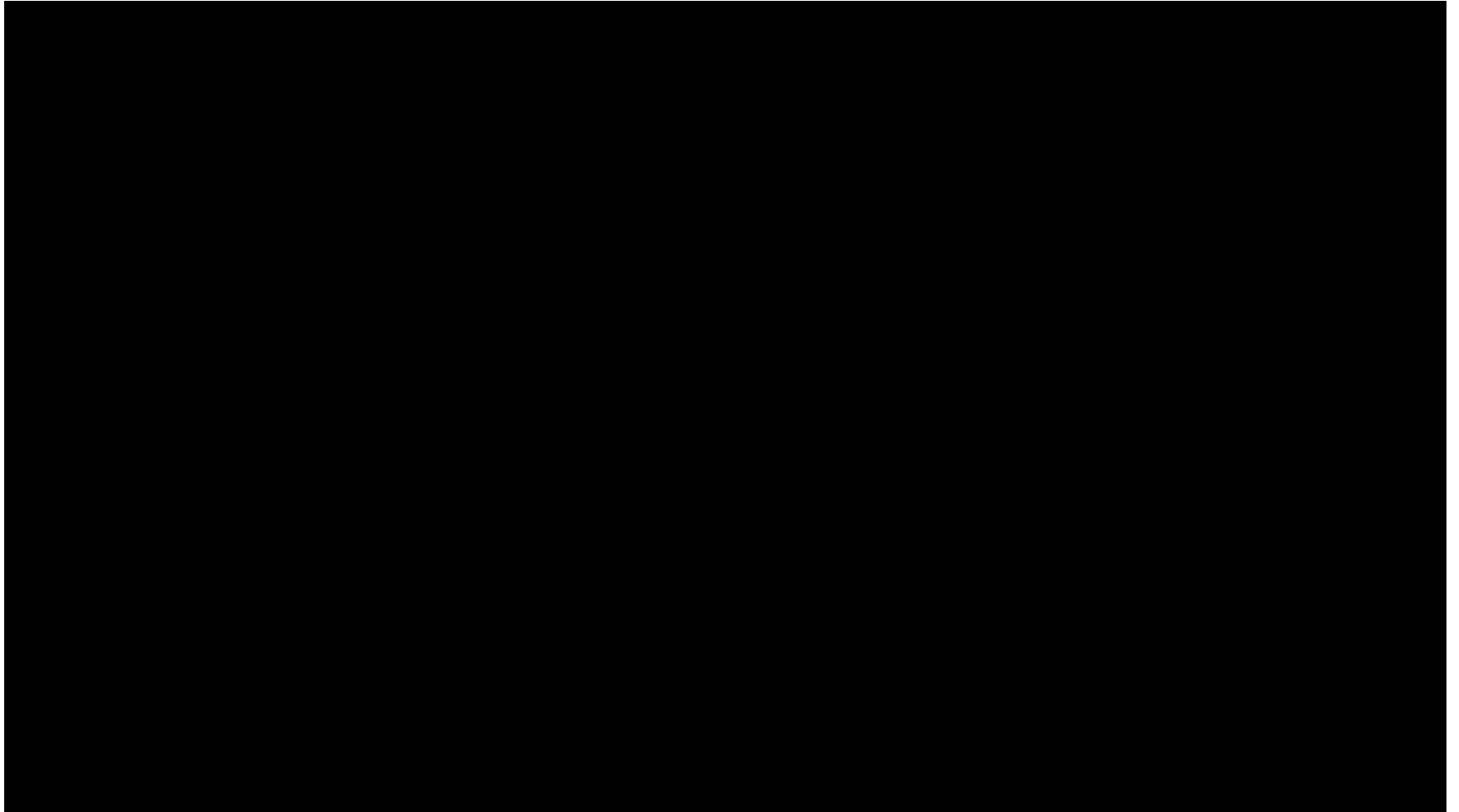

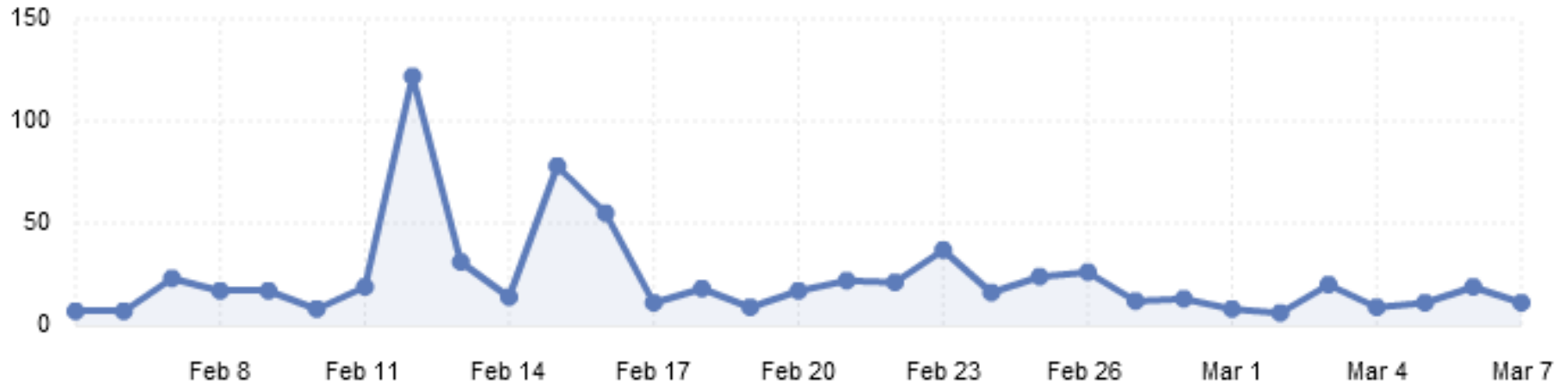

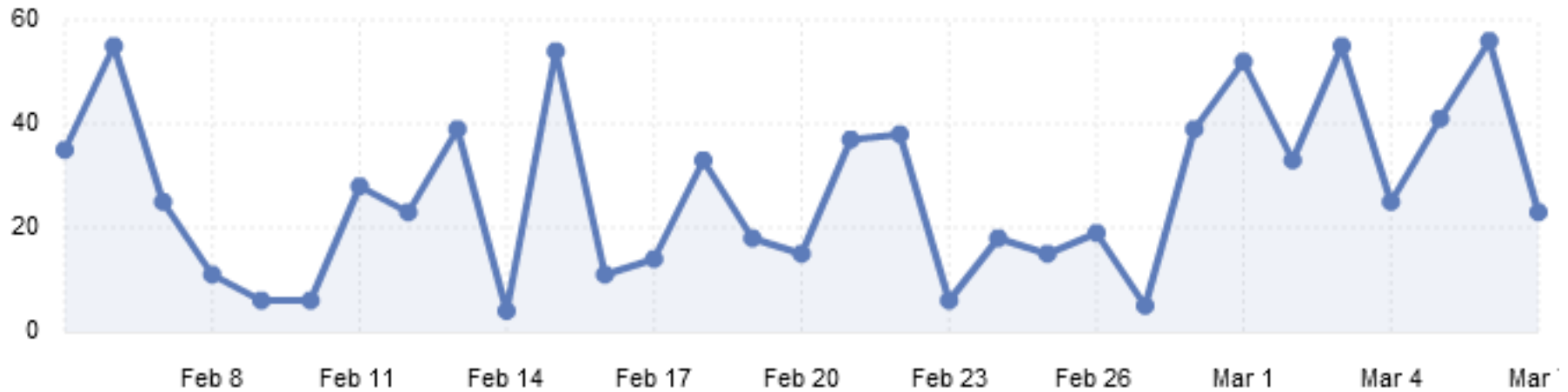
Pageviews Unique Visitors

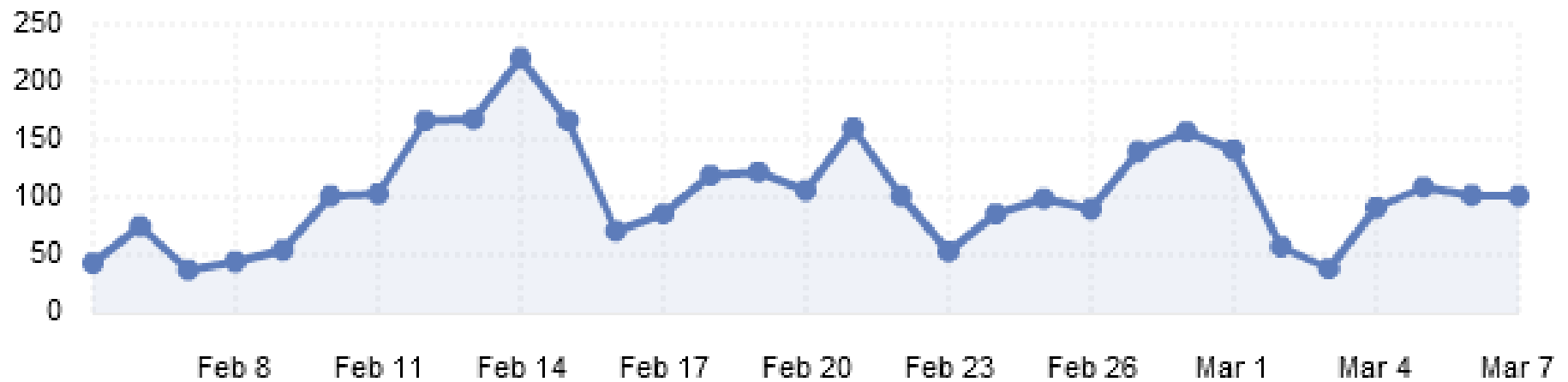
