

IMPROVE READING COMPREHENSION

- Create a HOME Library: Let your child select books to add to a home library - and add books you enjoy. Increasing access will increase reading time.
- READ TOGETHER: Have your child read to you, or you read to him.
 Try taking turns page for page or doing voices for different characters. This will spur interest and engagement.
- Play WORD games! Do crosswords, word searches, rhyming challenges, or ask your child to choose a correct definition of a random word you pick from the dictionary. Increasing vocabulary can increase fluency, the ability to read difficult texts, and improve test scores.





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- ♦ ASK QUESTIONS: What do you think will happen next? What was your favorite part? Who was your favorite character? Which character is the most like you? Increase engagement and make children give examples from the book to support their answers.
- Make your OWN BOOKS! Have your child come up with different endings for stories or BRAND NEW stories and write them down to share!





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
